Applications are being accepted through May 10, 2019 and the scholarship recipient will be invited to attend our monthly luncheon in July or August to be recognized.

In order to qualify for the scholarship, there are only a few requirements:

- You must attend one of the following North Jacksonville high schools: First Coast, Jackson, Ribault or Raines.
- You must have a cumulative high school GPA of at least 3.0.
- You must be enrolled to attend an accredited two- or four-year college in the fall of 2018, with preferential consideration to students enrolled in a Jacksonville college/university – Univ. of North Florida, Jacksonville University, Edward Waters College, Florida State College Jacksonville.
- You must complete this application in full, including a one-page essay (Approx. 500 words) about why you should be awarded the scholarship.

The recipient will be invited to attend the JAX Chamber North Council July or August lunch at the Jacksonville Zoo to meet the members and be recognized.

The scholarship will be awarded for the fall semester. The money will be deposited into the student's account at the college.
